



Wedding Reception Information

Paige Hall – Accommodates up to (175) guests with a dance floor or up to (250) guests with additional guest seating in The Barn.

Outdoor Tent Weddings – Accommodates up to (200) guests with a dance floor. Additional charges will be applied.

Reservations – The Barn & Paige Hall are reserved for five hour intervals, including the one hour cocktail reception prior to dinner. Additional time may be added for an additional \$250.00 per half hour.

NOTE: Evening receptions may not continue past 1:00 AM

Event Times and Guest Minimums for Paige Hall – Fridays and Sundays may be reserved for any five hours available with a (50) person package minimum. Saturday receptions during the months of April through December are reserved during the day until 5:00 PM and in the evening from 6:30 PM to 11:30 PM.

Facility Fee and Restrictions Apply to Saturday and Holiday Weddings – All Saturday and holiday weddings have a \$500.00 facility fee. Saturday evenings during the months of April through December must generate a food minimum revenue of \$7,500.00 excluding liquor, tax, service charge and facility fees.

Onsite Ceremonies – The Gazebo, located on our beautifully landscaped grounds, is available at \$500.00 which includes up to (100) white chairs. Additional chairs may be ordered for an additional fee. Alternate outdoor sites are also available. NOTE: Ceremony space will be reserved indoors in the event weather is inclement.

Our historic Barn, located inside, is a charming location for a romantic ceremony, holding up to 90 guests with a center aisle and two different options for your ceremonial view.

Overnight Accommodations – We offer seventeen historic rooms at the Publick House Historic Inn, six suites in the Chamberlain House and ninety-two rooms at the Country Lodge. Reservations by room block are recommended upon signing your wedding contract to ensure availability.

Tax and Service Charges – All food and beverage costs are subject to a 5% Massachusetts meal tax, a 15% service charge and a 3% taxable administrative fee.

Deposits, Prepayment and Additional Payments – An initial, non-refundable \$1,500.00 deposit is due two weeks from the date of reserving your wedding date. An additional deposit equal to 50% of your estimated balance is due six months prior to your wedding. Your guaranteed count of attendance is due ten business days prior to your wedding with an additional deposit due seven business days prior to your wedding. Additional deposits are payable by certified bank check or cash only. Any charges billed on consumption or are estimated will be due on departure.

Cancellation Policy – All deposits are non-refundable. All cancellation notices must be in writing and are effective on the date of receipt by the Publick House Historic Inn. Cancellations received six months or less than the date of the wedding will be charged the minimum guaranteed amount on all food and beverage contracted, in addition to any facility fees and lost revenues to the Publick House Historic Inn.
